Glass restoration includes the removal of staining, spotting, etching and scratches from a variety of glass surfaces. Metal restoration includes removal of staining, oxidation and corrosion from stainless steel & non-ferrous metals (aluminum, brass, bronze and copper). In addition, technicians apply protective coatings to glass and non-ferrous metals.

Potential candidates must possess the ability to multi-task, have an attention to detail and be respectful of surrounding work areas. Technicians must be professional, teachable, able to operate power tools and have the ability to learn specialized restoration techniques.
